### To view your library's Zinio collection:

1. Enter the information requested in the box above and click 'Log In'.
2. Click on the magazine you would like to view.
3. You will be asked to create a free Zinio account, or log in if you have an existing Zinio account.
4. If you wish to navigate back to your library's Zinio page, click the 'Back' arrow on your browser until the page appears.
5. If you would like to view your magazines via a Zinio app, use the email address and password you entered when you created your personal Zinio account to log into the app.









After selecting a magazine to view, patrons are prompted to create a free Zinio account or log back in if they already have an existing Zinio account. Their Zinio account allows them to view and manage their magazines either online or via one of the many Zinio apps available including PC, Mac, iPad, iPhone, Android, Kindle Fire and Blackberry Playbook:






