



**Abstract:** The Kellogg photograph collection, donated to the Library in 1970 by Bert Kellogg, consists of over 5,000 images of the local area dating from the 1850s through the 1970s. It conveys a rich sense of the history of the Olympic Peninsula by documenting the social, cultural, commercial, and historical events of Clallam County. The Library is proposing to use trained staff and volunteers to digitize at least 1,000 of these images during this grant cycle. The fragile nature of the images presents a pressing need for the digitization to begin as soon as possible.
