

- Make at least 4 copies of your zine submit 3 and keep the others for yourself. Sharing and trading is a traditional aspect of zine culture! Entries will not be returned and may be added to a library's collection or used in promotional materials.
- By submission, the participants grant permission for the library to display. photograph & reproduce the submitted work for publicity purposes
