Dear Mr. Reed:

Referendum Measure No. 71 is a referendum for submission to the people. In accordance with RCW 29A.72.060, we supply the ballot title and ballot measure summary for Referendum Measure No. 71 (AN ACT Relating to further expanding the rights and responsibilities of state-registered domestic partners).

If this measure qualifies to appear on the ballot, it will bear the following ballot title:

BALLOT TITLE

<u>Statement of Subject</u>: The legislature passed Engrossed Second Substitute Senate Bill 5688 concerning rights and responsibilities of state-registered domestic partners [and voters have filed a sufficient referendum petition on this bill].

<u>Concise Description</u>: This bill would expand the rights, responsibilities, and obligations accorded state-registered same-sex and senior domestic partners to be equivalent to those of married spouses, except that a domestic partnership is not a marriage.

BALLOT MEASURE SUMMARY

Same-sex couples, or any couple that includes one person age sixty-two or older, may register as a domestic partnership with the state. Registered domestic partnerships are not marriages, and marriage is prohibited except between one man and one woman. This bill would expand the rights, responsibilities, and obligations of registered domestic partners and their families to include all rights, responsibilities, and obligations granted by or imposed by state law on married couples and their families.
