**STIPULATION AND ORDER TO  
CORRECT SCRIVENER'S ERROR**

**EX PARTE**

**I. STIPULATION**

The Attorney General, Petitioner No on 2124, and Sponsor Jim Walsh (Parties) hereby agree and stipulate as follows:

1. On July 25, 2024, the Parties filed a proposed Stipulation and Order to Amend PIID of I-2124.

2. On July 26, 2024, this Court signed the proposed Stipulation and Order to Amend PIID of I-2124.

3. The proposed Stipulation and Order to Amend PIID of I-2124 contained two scrivener's errors, inadvertently adding a hyphen in the statement of subject and omitting the word "also" from the concise description in the manner underlined below:

Initiative Measure No. 2124 concerns state long-term care insurance. This measure would provide that employees and self-employed people must elect to keep coverage

1 under RCW 50B.04 and could opt-out any time. It would also repeal a law governing an  
2 exemption for employees.

3 4. The statement of subject and concise description are part of the ballot title.  
4 RCW 29A.72.050(1). The ballot title for I-2124 became final in July 2023 and was not subject  
5 to revision in this proceeding. The parties did not intend to alter the ballot title for I-2124. The  
6 changes were inadvertent.

7 5. The Parties respectfully request that this Court enter an order correcting the  
8 parties' inadvertent errors while otherwise maintaining the agreed-upon modification to the PIID  
9 for I-2124.

6 The ballot title and PIID shall be displayed on the ballot substantially as follows:


7 Initiative Measure No. 2124 concerns state long term care insurance. This measure would
