



Certification of Dominion Voting Systems Democracy Suite 5.20

On February 10, 2025, Dominion Voting Systems requested certification of Democracy Suite 5.20 and associated software and firmware, for use in Washington State.

Upon examination of the system, the Secretary of State finds Democracy Suite 5.20 satisfies the requirements of Washington State law, has been certified by an independent testing authority and has received Election Assistance Commission certification. This version of the system consists of:
